Marking Scheme

(評分準則)

默書分四部分：

(1) 背默 (Recitation) 30%

- 背默 3-4 句句子，每個錯字扣 2 分，標點符號扣 1 分

(2) 重點詞語 (Target Vocabulary) 15%

- 默寫老師讀出的 5 個/組詞語，每個正確答案 3 分

(3) 課文 (Text) 55%

- 讀默默書範圍內的句子，每個錯字扣 2 分，標點符號扣 1 分

(4) 額外加分部分：主題詞語或時態動詞 (Thematic Vocabulary / Tenses) 30%

- 每個正確答案加 2 分



TIPS FOR REVISING DICTATION

1. Know the dictation scope.
2. Circle the unfamiliar words.
3. Study in small parts.
4. Write the easy and familiar words first, then the new words.
(not too many – about 5 each time, in small groups).
5. Try to check and correct your own work.
6. Put marks on mistakes, e.g. circle the wrong word, so it's easy to review.
7. Study for 30 minutes, take a short break, then study again.
8. Before dictation, review the parts with marks.

*Tip: Do revision every other day helps memory.
For example, study on Day 1, Day 3, and Day 5*



REMINDERS FOR DICTATION

1. Prepare your stationery.
2. Stay calm and relaxed. If nervous, take deep breaths.
3. Listen carefully. Write only after the teacher finishes.
4. Write neatly and clearly. Don't write too slowly.
5. If you don't know a word, leave a blank space. Fill it in later.
6. If you can't hear clearly, raise your hand and ask the teacher.
7. When you finish, check your work.
